

WELCOME HOME SOLDIER HARLEY DAVIDSON RAFFLE OFFICIAL RULES

Thank you for your interest in the Welcome Home Soldier Raffle for 2009.

Net proceeds raised from this event will go 100% to the Welcome Home Soldier campaign and LaPorte County Habitat for Humanity. The idea is to raise in excess of \$30,000 allowing Bethany the ability to donate to LaPorte County Habitat for Humanity the funds to build the Welcome Home Soldier home on one of the "F" Street lots owned by Habitat. Your investment in this great event will assist in making the dreams of affordable home ownership a reality for a deserving veteran or veteran widow(er)! By entering this charity raffle, you are stating that you have read the raffle rules and understand them. If you have any questions about the rules below please call our office and we will do our best to answer all of your questions. Bethany Lutheran Church thanks you for your support of this wonderful cause!

1. Must be at least 18 years of age at the time of entry and a legal resident of the United States to be eligible.
2. Grand Prize Winner will take ownership of a 2009 Harley-Davidson Road King Motorcycle to be obtained from Kerstings Harley-Davidson in North Judson/Winamac, IN. Winner is responsible for picking up /delivery of motorcycle. Winner will be provided with the location of the Harley-Davidson dealership, so that they may complete ownership documents and pay all applicable fees.
Or winner may choose a cash equivalent prize as determined by the dealership rather than the motorcycle. The raffle will also give you the chance to win two (2) \$500 cash prizes and four (4) \$100 cash prizes
3. Winners need not be present to win.
4. Winners shall be responsible for any and all federal, state and local income or excise taxes, fees, assessments, licensing, registration, insurance and like charges associated with the prize. For IRS requirements and Government rules governing withholding of prizes won, check with a qualified financial adviser. The IRS has taken the position that amounts paid for chances to participate in raffles, lotteries or similar programs are not gifts and, therefore, the price of the entry does not qualify as a deductible charitable contribution.
5. Employees of Bethany Lutheran Church are not eligible to participate in the raffle.
6. Raffle starts on April 1, 2009 and ends no later than 2:00 pm on July 4, 2009 Tickets will be sold through July 4, 2009 or until tickets have been sold out, whichever occurs first. Phone/Mail/Email ticket sales made after June 28, 2009 will require personal pick up of original raffle ticket prior to July 4, 2009. Original raffle tickets will be mailed to tickets purchasers who have purchased via phone, mail or email.
7. Winners will be drawn at random on July 4, 2009 at Bethany Lutheran Church, LaPorte, IN immediately following the July 4th Parade.
8. Tickets are \$20.00 each and a total of 2,500 tickets will be sold. There is no limit of tickets that can be sold to an individual purchaser. Tickets can be paid for by cash, check, money order, or debit card. Checks are to be made payable to Bethany Lutheran Church. Tickets purchased via phone, mail, or email will be mailed to the purchaser within 6 days of order. Phone, mail or email order sales made after June 28, 2009 will require personal pick up of original raffle ticket prior to July 4, 2009.
9. If a cash equivalent prize is chosen for the Grand Prize in lieu of a motorcycle, terms for obtaining the cash equivalency prize shall be made with Kerstings Harley-Davidson in North Judson/Winamac, IN.
10. Prizes must be claimed within 30 days of notification. Should any prize not be claimed within the 30 days, it will then be forfeited to Bethany Lutheran Church to benefit Welcome Home Soldier fundraiser for LaPorte County Habitat for Humanity.
11. Upon issuance of a raffle ticket, all sales are final and non-refundable.
12. Bethany Lutheran Church assumes no responsibility for lost, late, misdirected, mutilated, incomplete, illegible or non-delivered entries. Any mutilated, incomplete or illegible entries will be deemed invalid and shall be immediately disqualified.
13. Any unsold tickets become the property of Bethany Lutheran Church.
14. 100% of the net proceeds from this raffle benefit LaPorte County Habitat for Humanity for a specific "Welcome Home Soldier" build – for a specific deserving veteran or veterans widow(er).
15. Driver's license or other acceptable form of identification along with the winning ticket stub must be presented before claiming any prize.

Purchasers, by participating (and the winner, by accepting the prize) release the employees of Bethany Lutheran Church and their respective partners, vendors, agents, representatives, board members, sponsors, service agencies and independent contractors, and each of their respective directors, officers, partners, employees and agents, including advertising and promotion agencies, from any and all liability with respect to participation in the raffle and possession or use of the prize awarded and also acknowledge that they did not receive any representations, warranty or guarantee, express or implied, in fact or in law, relative to the prize, including but not limited to its quality, mechanical condition or fitness. In the case of any dispute, Bethany Lutheran Church's decision shall be final.
